SEBELIUS, Case 1:12-cv-01344-ABJ (D.D.C.)).

"We are very pleased that Chad has been recognized for his hard work in the complex areas of FDA regulatory and intellectual property matters involving life sciences products," said James Veltrop, founding partner of Axinn, Veltrop & Harkrider, who nominated Mr. Landmon for the award. "We thank UConn for this recognition."
