Shishene Jing leverages government experience and academic economics training to represent U.S. and foreign companies in international investigations and complex antitrust litigation.

As a trial attorney at the Federal Trade Commission in the Bureau of Competition Technology Enforcement Unit, Shishene helped drive the AI workstream for the agency's investigation into a large technology company, helped author significant portions of the FTC's 6(b) report analyzing the industrial organization of the AI industry, and participated in the Meta antitrust enforcement that went to a month-long trial. Shishene also leverages trial experience as a former assistant federal public defender to represent clients in high-stakes litigation matters.

Before attending Yale Law School, where she served as an Articles Editor on the Yale Law Journal focusing on law and economics scholarship, Shishene was a business analyst at McKinsey & Company where she worked on post-merger management projects in the healthcare and medical devices industry.
