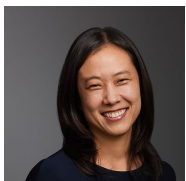

On January 29, Axinn partner Jacklin Chou Lem will speak on the “Antitrust: Novel Theories of Harm – Where are the Limits?” panel at Global Competition Review’s *Navigating the Future of Antitrust Conference*, being held January 28-30 in Miami.

- Continued interest in cross-border private antitrust litigation;
- U.S. enforcement trends under the Trump administration; and
- Outlook for novel theories of harm in 2026 and beyond.

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
