

Axinn Matter Named 2013 GCR Matter of the Year

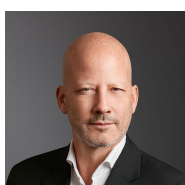

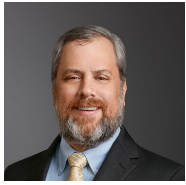
